Community Based Health and First Aid Trainings

BRIEF INFORMATION FOR PARTNERS



I. General Information

The Red Crescent Society of Tajikistan (RCST) is the oldest and biggest humanitarian organization in Tajikistan providing assistance to people in need since 1927. RCST strictly promoting Fundamental Principles of International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement within the framework of implementing programs on health issues, disaster preparedness and disaster response, branch development closely cooperates with governmental structures, non-governmental and international organizations with the aim of protection and relieving condition of vulnerable strata of population.

The RCST has branches in all 69 districts and counts more than 15.000 of volunteers throughout the country. In 2010, Parliament of Tajikistan adopted a law on “The Red Crescent Society of Tajikistan” and recognized some governmental guarantees and benefits to the organization.



II. Community Based First Aid Training Programs.

The Red Crescent Society of Tajikistan implements Community Based Health and First Aid Program (CBHFA) since 1997. The main modules and curriculums of the CBHFA were developed in close cooperation with the Netherlands Red Cross. During the period of this program activity more than 4000 volunteers were involved into RCST first aid trainings.

RCST has professional first aid trainers in all regions of the country. RCST systematically provides refreshment courses for the CBHFA trainers in national, as well as international levels.

RCST is only one organization of Tajikistan which has statutory approval from the Ministry of Justice to implement first aid training programs in the country. All first aid trainers have strong capacity to use modern interactive methods in Tajiki and Russian. RCST has official permission to give FA Certificate to the participants of the trainings. In February 2009 the Red Crescent Society of Tajikistan obtained official license of the Ministry of Education to conduct professional first aid trainings.

III. First Aid in Emergency

First Aid Program closely integrated with RCST Disaster Management activities. CBHFA topics are included into the base training course for Disaster Management staff. In disaster situations FA professionals and volunteers work in the Disaster Response Team. During the last year disasters in Vanj (2010), Kulob (2010) RCST first aid volunteers provided emergency first aid to hundreds of suffered people. CBHFA is the important component of DIPECHO.

IV. Types of training programs

RCST has developed different types of the first aid trainings depending of the target groups:

- One-day training for general population in rural area;
- Two-days training for DM and humanitarian workers;
- Two-days training for embassies and international agencies (core staff, drivers, guards etc.).

The various trainings can be provided upon request of the respected agencies.

V. Partnership

RCST have established very good relationships with the partners. The flexible management structure, trained staff and volunteers, modern methods and approaches, are very attractive for our partners and donors.

Organizations received RCST FA trainings are: IFRC, ICRC, UNHCR, MSF, Merlin, British Embassy, Tajikistan Air Company, Tajikistan Railway, Fire Departments, Ministry of Interior, and "Hyatt" Hotel Complex.



Fee-based Red Cross/Red Crescent First Aid Training Courses

Six modern and well-equipped training centers: Dushanbe, Kulob, Qurghonteppa, Khujand, Khorugh, Direct Rule Districts.

Twenty four district training rooms: Tursunzoda, Hisor, Rudaki, Varzob, Asht, Mastchoh, Isfara, Jabbor Rasulov, Vakhsh, Jillikul, Rumi, Khuroson, Baljuvon, Mu'minobod, Hamadoni, Vose', Darvoz, Vanj, Shughnon, Roshtqal'a, Fayzobod, Rasht, Nurobod, Tavildara.



Trainers: All trainers have rich experience on FA education programs. Four master trainers have international First Aid certificates.

Details of trainings:

Educational Level: First (basic)

Duration: 2 days (16 hours)

Fee: 30 USD/per participant/per day. If number of participants will be more than 20 people – 25 USD per day

Included: Payment for a trainer, certificate, training (imitation) materials
